How To Save DQTcam Videos from Incidents or Accidents

DQTcam video records are saved to the local SD card in the camera (64GB each). The SD cards typically allow 5-7 days' worth of recorded events.

Once the SD cards are full, the stored events are then overwritten as new events are generated.

Anytime there is an accident or any incident involving your fleet, you should promptly pull the SD cards from the camera and copy the events over to a local PC or storage to prevent any possibility of overwriting the events.


If evidence is recovered from an SD Card, it is best practice to keep the SD card for evidence and utilize a new SD card in the Dash-cam when it is put back into use.

Sep by Step Directions for Pulling Video from SD Cards

Take out the main unit (without powering on) and turn the card slot panel at the bottom of the main unit counterclockwise with the L-shaped socket head wrench in the package to open the panel.



SD Card slots are labeled TF1 and TF2 in the graphic below. **IMPORTANT:** Note which SD card is in each slot when they are removed as you will need to put them back to the same spot later.




If you would like more retention time before the overwriting, you can use larger SD cards. The videos will still be overwritten once there is no more room for new recording.

In order for an event to be available from the website, it needs to be requested by a user from .NET so it is uploaded and available. The uploaded events will only be low resolution, so pulling the SD card is the better option especially if a police ticket, or insurance get involved.



- b. Follow the prompts on the computer to download the program.

Once installation is complete hit **Finish** and the program will Launch




Steps to Retrieve a Video Clip

How To Select the Video Clip

1. Look for your file name. (Will be labeled as SD on the left side of the application)
2. Your Camera ID will also show on the left



3. Double click the device, a calendar will show on the bottom left.
 - a. A red dot on the date indicates there is footage from that date
4. Double click on the date and press play



5. To back up the footage, click on the scissor icon and move the dotted line
 - a. Click the OK button
 - b. Select the channel(s) you want to save, the video format and where you want to save it
